Standard Finish for Fiberglass Poles

Fiberglass poles have the same standard color offering as our metal poles. There can be some variation in the color match between metal and fiberglass caused by the difference in material and the method the finish is applied.

We supply round fiberglass poles that are filament wound. This process spiral wraps the continuous strands around a revolving mandrel. The strands are impregnated with resin that has been saturated with the color pigment prior to being wound. The pole is then painted with UV-resistant wet paint to match the color requested.

The same principle applies to square fiberglass poles. The filaments are impregnated with resin that has been saturated with the color pigment then, pulled through a die in a continuous operation.
